What are FamilyHealth Medical Clinics?

FamilyHealth Medical Clinics are full-service medical clinics offering primary and specialty care to patients of all ages. We have clinics located in Northfield, Lonsdale, Farmington and Lakeville. The clinics are a service of Northfield Hospital, with physician services provided by Cannon Valley Clinic–Mayo Health System and other premier medical providers in the region. FamilyHealth Medical Clinics make primary care services more accessible throughout the area and provide additional specialty services to the communities served.

What medical services do you provide?

Our health service team includes physicians who practice family medicine, pediatrics, OB/GYN, internal medicine and general surgery. Through our FamilyHealth network, you'll also have ready access to physicians who practice urology, orthopedics, ENT (ear, nose and throat), adult and pediatric cardiology, medical oncology, and high-risk pregnancy care. The Center for Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation (CSMR), another service of Northfield Hospital, provides services in Northfield and in the Train America facility adjacent to our Lakeville clinic.

Do you accept my insurance?

We accept all major health insurance plans. Should referral to more specialized care be necessary, we will honor your preferences and insurance requirements.

Can I be seen promptly when I need to be?

Same-day appointments are available. We know that when you need to be seen, you want to be seen today.

A full complement of skilled surgeons offer a variety of specialties, including laparoscopic surgery, orthopedics, OB/GYN, urology, oral surgery and ophthalmology. Other services of the hospital include the Women's Health Center of Northfield Hospital, the Orthopaedic and Fracture Clinic of Northfield, the Center for Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation, and Children's Therapy and Speech.
